

## 2022 Diversity Bar Study Scholarship **Sponsored by the CLA Litigation Section**

The East Bay La Raza Lawyers Association ("EBLRLA") and the EBLRLA Scholarship Fund have partnered with the Litigation Section of the California Lawyers Association ("CLA") to present a 2022 Diversity Bar Study Scholarship for law students in their final year of law school who have demonstrated an intent to pursue a career in litigation and have shown commitment to serving the Latinx community.

**PURPOSE**: To recognize a law student in their final year who will take the California Bar Exam and has:

- Shown excellence and achievement in law school;
- Overcome personal hardships or challenges;
- Has a demonstrated financial need (preference will be given to students who do not already have bar study expenses covered);
- Demonstrated intent to pursue a career in litigation following graduation;
- Demonstrated leadership potential and a history of involvement with Latinx student, professional, or civic organizations; and
- Demonstrated service in support of their local Latinx communities and commitment to social justice.

**AWARD**: One (1) scholarship of \$5,000.

**APPLICATION PROCESS**: Complete this application form and include the following:

- *Résumé*. Two-page maximum. Please include any litigation work experience you have.
- *Transcript.* Please include a copy of your law school transcript. Unofficial copies are acceptable. Your law school enrollment and grade point average are subject to verification.
- **Proof of Financial Need.** Please include any supporting documentation to verify your law school debt and overall student loan debt.
- Essay Submission. Two-page maximum. The essay should address how you fulfill the abovementioned purpose of the scholarship.

## ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- You must be planning to sit for the California Bar Exam and use the scholarship for bar study/exam expenses within nine months of award disbursement. (Anticipated award disbursement: March 2022.)
- You may only receive one bar study scholarship sponsored by the CLA Litigation Section. If you have already received or will receive a CLA-sponsored scholarship from another bar association, you are not eligible to apply.
- If an employer is already providing you with a bar study stipend, you are not eligible to apply.
- Be or become a Law Student member of EBLRLA. To join, visit our website www.eblrla.org/join.
- Applicants are strongly encouraged to become members of the CLA Litigation Section after passing the California Bar Exam and securing full-time employment. Law students may join for free.
- The scholarship recipient must attend and volunteer at the 2022 East Bay La Raza Lawyers Association Gala where they will be recognized in person. Date to be announced.

**DEADLINE:** Electronic submission via email by **Friday**, **January 28**, **2022** by 11:59 PM.
